Policy ADM-c-80 Access to Health Information

Records Requiring Review before Disclosure

Examples of the types of records **that should not be disclosed** without review:

- Psychological and psychiatric records.
- Results of diagnostic or psychological tests or assessments.
- Records containing information from family counseling sessions unless consent to disclosure is provided by all participants.
- Records containing procedures or results of an investigation, discipline proceeding or similar matter relating to a health services provider.
- Records that could reveal the identity of an organ or tissue donor or recipient.
- Records that could reveal information about adoptions or adopted persons.
- Records that could reveal the identity of an informant in a child welfare matter.
- Quality assurance records created or received by a quality assurance committee as defined in the *Alberta Evidence Act*.
