How is McConnell Place unique?

- small, one-story buildings located in a residential neighbourhoods
- o 12 residents in each of three houses; 36 spaces total in each home
- o each house within the home has its own kitchen and dining room
- most of the rooms are private; three semi-private rooms in each home
- each room has a private bathroom with a shower
- o central common areas for indoor recreation and social activities
- o enclosed outdoor areas with walking paths, flower and shrub beds
- residents participate in familiar activities such as gardening, housekeeping and baking
- families are welcome and encouraged to participate in activities of daily living and special occasions
- buildings are secured by keypads
