Comprehensive Home Option of Integrated Care for the Elderly (CHOICE) South Restorative

What is CHOICE South Restorative?

CHOICE South Restorative is a short-term, intensive rehabilitation program that helps clients improve or maintain their health and independence. This program is guided by a “work with you” approach, where clients are expected to be active participants in setting and working toward functional goals.



Who is eligible for CHOICE South Restorative care?

Adults in Edmonton who:

- are experiencing the loss of functional independence due to acute illness, injury, or prolonged hospitalization.
- live in the community and would benefit from a coordinated short-term restorative rehabilitation program and medical oversight to recover their functional independence.

Clients do not need to be a registered with home care to be eligible to receive this service.

What services are provided?

Clients will come to the **CHOICE Centre on Parsons Road** two or more times a week. Based on their identified goals and care plan, they can receive the following:

- Medical monitoring and treatment by CHOICE nurse practitioners and other nurses
- Rehabilitation or restorative therapy
- Therapeutic recreation, cognitive and social programs
- Personal assistance with daily tasks like going to the washroom (as needed)
- Health and wellness education
- Meals and snacks
